BE IT KNOWN THAT, by this [FELONY COMPLAINT], INV. CHAD M. MCCARTY  
as the Complainant herein, [stationed] [redacted] at SP PULASKI BCI  
accuses PATRICK F. MCLEOD OF 293 BARBER RD. ALTMAR, NY 13302

the above mentioned Defendant(s), with having committed the [FELONY]  
of MURDER 2ND, in violation of Section 125.25  
Subdivision 1 of the PENAL Law of the State of New York.

That on or about the 7TH day of JUNE, 2009, at about 11:00AM in the  
TOWN of ALBION, County of OSWEGO, the  
defendant(s) did intentionally, knowingly and unlawfully commit the FELONY of MURDER 2ND.

A person is guilty of Murder in the second degree when, with intent to cause the death of another person, he causes the death of such person or of a third person.  
TO WIT: on the aforementioned time, date and place said defendant did intentionally cause the death of Marie K. McLeod (dob 08/17/62) by striking her several times with a baseball bat and stabbing the victim several times with a knife. All contrary to said statute in such case made and provided.

state the following: I am currently employed with the New York State Police and hold the rank of Trooper and have held such position for 3 years. I am stationed out of SP Pulaski, 3273 Co Rte 2, Pulaski NY, 13142. At approximately 6:50 a.m. this morning 6/08/2009 I was returning to the station for end of shift in marked unit 3D44. As I pulled into the station driveway I observed a gray Jeep Liberty parked in the front parking lot. The Vehicle was parked paralleling Co Rte 2 with the front of the vehicle facing in a westerly direction. I also observed that the vehicle was occupied by a white male who appeared to be sleeping in the drivers seat with the seat in a reclined position. After observing the vehicle I pulled in the parking lot and paralleled the Jeep with the passenger side of marked unit 3D44 paralleling the driver side of the gray Jeep. I rolled down the passenger side window and asked the operator who was later identified as Patrick F. McLeod if I could offer any assistance and if everything was o.k.? McLeod, who was laying back in his seat, turned his head toward me and said "NO!" I further asked, "What seems to be the problem?" McLeod stated "I have domestic problems!" At that point I exited my vehicle and walked over to the driver side door McLeod's Jeep. Standing outside and facing the driver side door I asked "You are having domestic problems, is it with your wife or girlfriend and how bad are things going?" McLeod replied "Real bad, as bad as they can get!" I then asked "What do you mean by that?" McLeod replied "I killed her!!" "You killed who?" I asked. McLeod replied "My wife!". McLeod then explained that he killed his wife sometime yesterday. McLeod explained that he and his wife had got into an argument sometime yesterday while driving in his vehicle, which upset him. McLeod then stated he killed his wife with a baseball bat and a knife. I asked McLeod "are you sure she is dead?" McLeod stated "I am sure!" At that point I asked McLeod to step out of his vehicle and that I was placing him under arrest. As McLeod was exiting his vehicle I noticed a white substance on the front of his pants and shirt. I asked McLeod if the substance on his clothes was from his wife. He replied that it was vomit.

PEOPLE vs. Patrick F. McLeod

After McLeod exited his vehicle, I placed him under arrest and placed him in handcuffs. I lead McLeod from his vehicle to the front door of the station where Tpr Pelton and Tpr Mierek were standing. I explained to both Tpr Pelton and Mierek that Mr. McLeod is stating that he killed his wife and to start making notification. I then lead McLeod into the station patrol room and read him his Miranda Rights which was at 6:55 a.m. McLeod stated he understood his rights as they were read. Afer McLeod was read his rights, he explained that his wife was their residence at 293 Barber Rd. in the Town of Albion. Tpr Pelton and Meirek went to the residence where it was confirmed McLeod's wife was deceased
